

Catch up Premium

This funding is provided by government to support Yr. 7 children who did not reach the expected level in reading or Maths at the end of Key Stage 2.

In 2016-2017 St Augustine's received £9000

Evaluation of Effectiveness

10 children received additional support with reading

16 children received additional support with Maths

This intervention was delivered by a teacher who has particular experience working with children who have difficulties acquiring basic skills. Most of the work was conducted in small group withdrawal sessions. At times, this teacher supported the children in class if a specific context suggested this was more appropriate.

The impact of this intervention is shown below:

English – By the end of the year, 50% achieved expected level

40% improved but were not at expected level

10% did not improve

Those children who did not reach the expected level continue to receive support through the Learning Support Department and within class from their teacher and teaching partner and in some cases from the teacher who provided the catch-up intervention.

Maths – by the end of year 19% were at expected level

69% showed improvement but not yet reached expected level

12% showed no improvement

The children who did not reach the expected level continue to receive intervention in the form of small Maths groups with specific TP support and continued intervention from the teacher who provided the catch up intervention.

In 2017 – 2018, we will receive the same funding as in 2016 – 2017.

We will follow the same procedure as last year and 13 will be involved in English intervention and 9 in Maths intervention.
