

Uniform/Appearance

Every student is an ambassador of the College and at all times their appearance should reflect this, being smart, neat and tidy.

Sixth Form Uniform Requirements

An official Sixth Form uniform is available from Scholars in Trowbridge, Bath, Devizes and Warminster; substitutions are not acceptable.

Acceptable items of uniform are as follows:

Male

- Official black fitted blazer
- Black trousers
- Black sixth form tie
- College shirt (white with dark stripes)
- Black or dark grey socks with black shoes (no trainers, no boots)
- Long sleeved thin, plain, black, v necked jumper

Female

- Official black fitted blazer
- Grey Thompson Tartan skirt (these are available in different lengths but must not be worn more than two inches above the knee)
- Plain white blouse
- Plain black opaque (minimum 40 denier) or neutral tights.
- Plain black shoes (maximum 2 inch heel, no stilettos/sling backs/boots)
- Long sleeved thin, plain, black, v necked jumper

Blazers must be worn at all times, unless students are informed otherwise.

Students may wear one pair of discreet earrings (no more than an inch in length)

Facial piercings are not permitted. One small nose stud may be permitted **by prior arrangement** with, and at the discretion of, the Head of Sixth, all other uniform requirements having been met
Extreme hairstyles and hair colours are unacceptable and hair must be worn neatly (neutral coloured hair accessories may be worn to achieve this)

Neatly trimmed facial hair is permitted

No tattoos are permitted

Coats should not be worn indoors

Sixth Form students are asked to wear appropriate sportswear for their Recreation lessons. This must include trainers and should not be revealing.

Please take note of the school uniform requirements, and ensure that your child's appearance complies. Failure to do so may result in them being sent home to rectify the situation.
